Title of Document:	Primary Care Quality & Performance Report
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Summary	<p>This paper is produced as a draft of the formal reporting planned from the September meeting onwards and identifies and summarises the main national data reports and the London local performance reports of practices at a high level in the six CCGs in the South West London.</p> <p>This information is derived from the data that NHS England currently holds and receives from practices in South West London. The data sources are listed in liaison/sources below, and are used to identify themes from the submitted data.</p> <p>This information is held at a practice level and can be compared to national and local CCG achievements. The performance and quality issues identified inform dialogue with primary medical care contractors to drive improvement and or share best practice.</p> <p>This paper also gives an overview of the Primary Care contract changes that have occurred since the starting of the new arrangements in South West London including the changes that have taken place since 01st April 2015. It also shares, by a CCG level, clinician areas of concerns from the Medical Directorate for information.</p>
Localism	These reports are showing the actual data sets from the practices in South West London area. NHS England has been working with CCG primary care leads and local stakeholders to continue to improve primary care provision with CCG areas.
